Semester Program

- Non-Chinese-speaking exchange students are eligible to take "semester program" (group class) for up to 6 hours per week without tuition.
- For students who want to take courses other than "semester program" or more than 6 hours per week, tuition discount will be offered.
- "Record of Study" will be provided when reaches course requirements.
 - (* Non-compulsory, no credit provided).

Course Features

- Taught by experienced teachers.
- Small class of 20 students, meet twice per week.
- Class levels range from beginner to intermediate.
- On-line placement test.
