ENGLISH LANGUAGE

English presessional course - details about studying English with NU before starting your exchange studies.

English Requirements - the following minimum requirements are generally for undergraduate non final year exchange study, any unique English requirements will be noted within the relevant institutional agreement.

IELTS: overall 6.0 (with minimum of 5.5 in each component) **TOEFL IBT**: overall 79 (with minimum R18, W17, L17, S20)
